What happened in your experiment? Did the experiment work? What can you see? You will need:  Method: 1. Fill the large jar with water, leaving 2 inches at the top. 2. Add the shaving cream to the top of the water until it reaches the top of the jar. 3. Next, add 1 cup of water to the small bowl and 3 drops of blue food colouring. 4. Mix the water and food colouring together. 5. Use the pipette to add drops of the water mixture to the top of the shaving cream cloud. 6. Continue adding the water mixture until you begin to notice the raindrops begin to break through the bottom of the cloud.
