THUR	Maths <u>Nursery</u> – Making a pattern Find some different objects around your house that you can make a pattern with (Lego/building bricks are a great resource) Use the objects to make a pattern (You could make a colour pattern) Talk through the pattern with an adult. What colour would come next? Can you say the pattern?	Fine Motor <u>Nursery</u> – Messy play shaving foam. Put a little bit of shaving foam on a flat surface/plate. Can you make marks in the foam? Can you make a straight line? Can you draw a wiggly line? Have a go at tracing over your name. Have a go at writing your name! Wider Curriculum <u>RHE</u> – Talk with an adult about how you stay safe at home.
