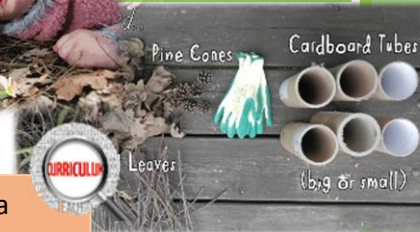
SPRING 2
