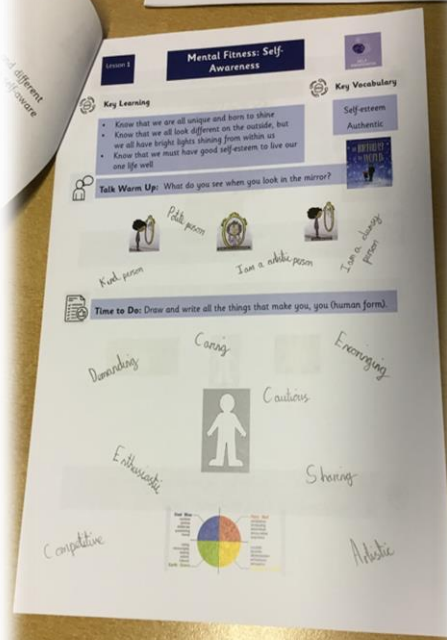
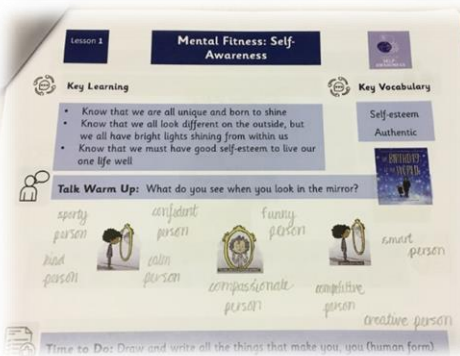
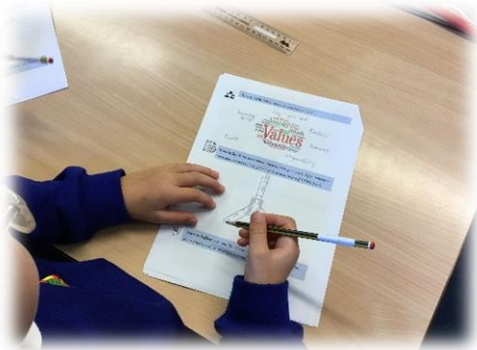

KS1 Library Club starts today. Children will be learning all about how to use the library and they will be making their own bookmark to bring home. Some children will start Library Club next Friday.

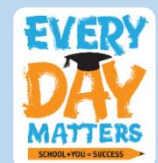
This is how our attendance looked in school this week:
